Games Play Day Rules/Disqualifications

1. Rider has one minute to enter course once the judge signals.
2. Circling pole, barrel or marker considered part of the course before officially entering the course.
3. Leaving the course, upsetting the starting poles after being given the course, crossing the starting plane outside the starting poles.
4. Crossing start/finish plane before completing course.
5. Riding off course or failure to complete the course as diagrammed
6. Hitting horse with any game equipment or hitting ahead of the elbows.
7. Loose horse (loss of contact with horse)
8. Must be mounted when starting and completing course
9. Un-sportsmanlike conduct. Judges will disqualify riders for the use of profane language, unnecessary roughness, abusing the horse, disorderly conduct of any kind, and disqualify an unmanageable horse for safety reasons.

Decisions of the judge shall be final.

Waiver of Liability

Every entry at a recognized show shall constitute an agreement and affirmation that the person making it, owner, lessee, trainer, manager, agent, coach, driver, rider and horse: (1) shall be subject to the local rules of the show; (2) that every horse, rider and/or driver is eligible as entered; (3) that the owner and any representatives are bound by they constitution and rules of the WSH/CZ/KSC and the show and will accept as the final decision of the hearing committee on any question arising under said rules and agree to hold the show, their officials, directors, volunteers, harmless for any actions taken; (4) that the owner, rider/driver and any of their agents or representatives acknowledge that they participate voluntarily in the show fully aware that horse sports and the show involve inherent dangerous risk and by participating they expressly assume any and all risks of injury or loss suffered during or in connection with the competition. Whether or not such injury or loss resulted, directly or indirectly, from the negligent acts or omissions of said officials, directors, volunteers or agents of the show. The construction or application of WHS/CZ/KSC rules are governed by the laws of the State of Washington, RCW 4.24. The undersigned releases the Kitsap Saddle Club, Canal Zone and Washington State Horsemen and all others working in connection with the show from all liabilities of any kind or character from loss, damage, injury or death of riders, handlers, horses and any equipment said owners or representatives may have on the grounds. If I am a parent or legal guardian of a junior rider, I consent to the child's participation and agree to all of the above provisions and to assume all of the obligation of this release on the child's behalf.
